

3 Sound Regular Words

The following wordlist to be used in segmentation and blending tasks and for early word reading and spelling tasks (after students have learnt basic sound-letter links). They are listed in alphabetical order. The words in brackets contain digraphs. These can be used for blending and segmenting tasks (that are auditory and verbal) but can only be used in word reading and writing tasks when digraphs have been explicitly taught.
