“Frogs on a Log” © is a program that can be used in many different ways. It is a perfect resource for early language groups, but also works well in individual sessions or for home practice.

The resource promotes both understanding and expression of number, colour and position.

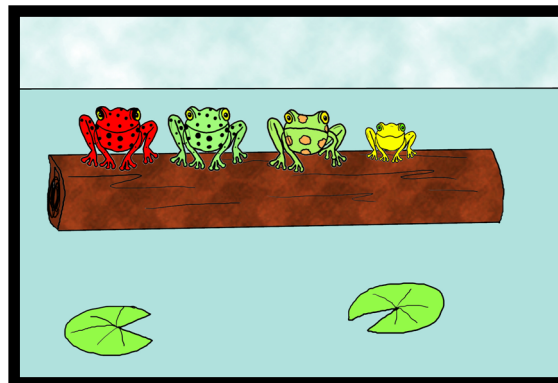
When using the resource, it’s a good idea to find a real log, some blue material for water and some toy frogs, so you can make learning hands-on. Alternatively, print out and laminate the frogs in the file, “Frogs, Logs and Lily Pads” and use these as your props.

NAME OF FILE/FOLDER	SUGGESTED USE	TYPE OF FILE
File: Record Sheet	Keep a record of progress.	PDF
Folder: Slideshow	Open with a picture viewer. Select all and look at each picture, saying the words as you go.	JPEG
File: Frogs, Logs and Lily Pads	Print out, cut up and laminate. Add some Velcro, or Blu-Tak and use as props in the song or simply in free play.	PDF
File: Colour-in, cut out and paste	A black and white page to print out. Discuss the frogs as they are decorated/coloured and discuss their location when they are stuck on the picture.	PDF
File: Colour-in	Similar to above, but the scene is already set! No cutting and pasting required.	PDF
File: Frog Song Lyrics	The lyrics to sing and ideas for leading the song with props.	PDF
File: Frog Song Sample	A sample of children singing the song so you can become familiar with the tune. Only one verse recorded.	WAV
File: Frogs on a Log	This is a video focusing on counting the frogs. It is repetitive and great for young learners.	WMV file (opens on computers using QuickTime or Windows Media Player etc...)
File: Frog Cards	6 matching pairs of frogs. Play Memory or Snap. Match cards. Talk about "same" and "different".	PDF
File: Frog Signs	Pages of Auslan signs. Use them as actions during the song and also throughout activities. A great way for kids to learn signs that can be used in different contexts.	PDF
Folder: Pictures	8 frog pictures that you can use to make more activities.	JPEG
